# LMTI ADMISSION INFORMATION

**Liberia Maritime Training Institute** is located at the scenic campus of Marshall City in Margibi County, adjacent to the Junk, Farmington and Du rivers and the Atlantic Ocean. It aims to become a world class learning community of excellence with the stated vision to lift and return the Liberian Maritime Heritage to its rightful position, while enhancing the capacity and quality of Liberia's future workforce.

# Liberia Maritime Training Institute (LMTI) invites applications for admission to its Associate of Science in Marine Engineering program (A.Sc.MarEng) offered by the Institute.

The **A.Sc.MarEng** program of LMTI is a 2-years' (4 semesters) full time on-campus residential course with modern learning facilities. The Institute will bear the full cost of training, foods and accommodation for the selected candidates. On successful completion of the course, the students have the options of pursuing a career either at sea or ashore or continue higher education in other Universities.

### Application Deadline:

- A. Starting Date of Application: June 17, 2024
- B. Closing Date of Applications: August 16, 2024

## **Eligibility Criteria for Admission**

To ensure a fair and transparent admission process, all candidates must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- A. The candidate (male/female) must be a Liberian citizen and age between 18 and 26 years old as on August 16, 2024.
- B. The candidate must be a science student and must have scored a minimum of 80% in Physics, chemistry, Mathematics, and English on the high school transcript.
- C. Candidate must have passed the West African Examinations Council (WAEC)/West African Senior School Certificate Examination (WASSCE) with a minimum of five subjects, including Mathematics, Physics, and English.
- D. Candidates must be physically and medically fit, with good eyesight and color vision.

### **Selection Process**

- A. Candidates are required to pass the LMTI Aptitude Test (50 marks 1 hour), which assesses cognitive abilities and reasoning skills, to advance to the next stage of the admission process.
- B. Candidates must pass the LMTI administered entrance examination in mathematics, physics, and English (100 marks 2 hours). A minimum score of 60% is required in each subject for consideration.
- C. Candidates must successfully pass the LMTI-administered oral exam, which is conducted as an interview. The interview aims to assess candidates' communication skills and understanding.
- D. Candidates must undergo physical and medical fitness tests, including an eyesight test (20/20 vision) and a color vision test.
- E. Candidates must successfully verify all original documents, including police clearance.

\***Note 01:** Attach scan **c**opies (online application) and photocopies (manual application) of following documents along with application form:

- A. High School Diploma certificate and transcript.
- B. WAEC/WASSCE certificate.
- C. Birth certificate and National ID mandatory, Passport (optional). Information of birth certificate and national ID must match to be eligible for admission.
- D. Recent passport size photo (2 copies for manual application).
- E. Police Clearance Certificate.
