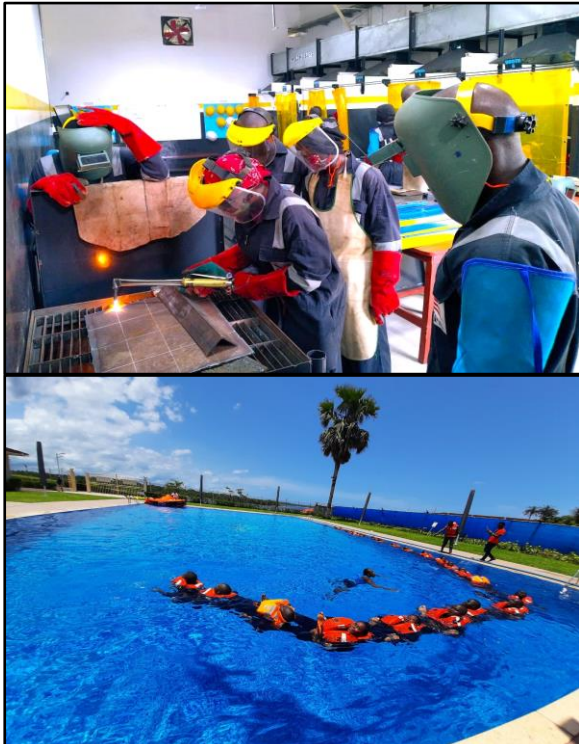


## Our Vision

## Liberia Maritime Training Institute

### An introduction

The scenic campus of Liberia Maritime Training Institute sits adjacent to the Junk, Farmington and Du rivers and the Atlantic Ocean. It aims to become a world class learning community of excellence. Ship owners around the world require competent and trained seafarers to man their vessels. As Liberia is the owner of the largest ship registry in the world, it is responding to the needs of its customers and the international market place by opening the LMTI, to facilitate quality training and to produce well-trained, fully qualified and certified seafarers in accordance with the Standards of Training, Certifications and Watch-keeping (STCW) Conventions and Code.

## Admission

For the Pre-Sea Marine Engineering course, applications are invited from Liberian High school graduates aged 18-26 years from all counties and put through a rigorous entrance test, physical and medical fitness tests. Those who clear the tests are shortlisted for interviews after which final selections will be done. The cost of training, foods and accommodation are fully borne by the Institute.

### Associate of Science Degree in Marine Engineering - 2 Years ( A.Sc.MarEng)

This 4-semester course leading to an Associateship Degree prepares the student to sail on board cargo ships as trainee Engine room ratings. For those who wish to continue further studies, options will be available to obtain admissions to Degree courses in other technical or marine based programs, subject to University admission rules.

Apart from careers at sea, prospective students who successfully completes the program may opt for shore-based careers in various local industries, where there is a great need for highly competent technical staff.
